For Intermediate to Advanced Students: This two day workshop focuses on wet into wet watercolor techniques, color, value, and compositional structure with some aesthetic considerations added in for good measure.

DAY ONE: Karen will lecture about her specific palette and how it pertains to wet into wet. A demonstration of a purposeful underpainting will follow. In the afternoon, students will have an opportunity to develop their own underpainting.

DAY TWO: Karen will return to her established underpainting and demonstrate how to complete the painting. The focus will be on a calculated approach to wet into wet applications such as the development of a complex wash by increasing the pigment/water ratio progressively. In the afternoon, students will return to their paintings for their own stab at wet into wet.
