Peggi's Figure and Still Life Workshop

Workshop: In this workshop the figure will be the subject matter, however the focus will be on improving drawing skills and seeing values and colors correctly, and understanding their relationships to each other. There will be daily demonstrations emphasizing the big shapes and establishing their relationships correctly. This provides a springboard to adding additional information if the individual artist desires. We will address design and technique in a manner in which the individual artist may express them selves in a personal way. The student will experience many specific assignments, which helps to "get to the point a little more quickly." Be ready to cover a lot of canvas and "learning through earnest mileage." Students will receive plenty of one-on-one instruction and individual demonstrations as needed.

Plein Air: Landscape, Seascape & Cityscape

A native Californian, David Savellano is an artist who works primarily en plein air (outdoors), creating watercolor paintings that capture random moments—on the street, in nature, and wherever else his portable easel takes him. Although largely self-taught as a watercolor painter, he credits his 30 years as a practicing architect with having given him the drawing skills and strong sense of perspective that have elevated his artwork to a professional level. As his many students will attest, he is also a very skillful and inspirational teacher with a very accessible approach to plein air painting.

Workshop: David will begin with a half-day lecture on plein air painting, his approach, materials, and equipment. At each of three sites, David will choose a scene to paint and students will gather around and paint along with him in a step-by-step method. By observing (taking photos as desired) and receiving individual coaching, students will learn David's approach to composition,

value planning, perspective, and painting techniques. Plein air painting will include a landscape seascape and a cityscape.
