President's Message-SFC

Mike Kirschel began his presentation with an engaging smile. His painting style looks simple and straightforward—use lots of paint applied liberally and check how it is affecting everything around it. Mix the colors on the canvas. "I'd like to try painting like that!," I heard someone say. On the wall behind him was his Best of Show painting, "Sunflowers." There were many questions, and Mike was happy to answer them all.

During his previous demo for SWA, Mike painted from a still life he set up for the purpose. Concentrating on his work, he had little to say. However, as he stepped back to look after almost each brush stroke, I could see how he was thinking. He worked with just one brush and a role of paper towels under his left arm, changing rapidly from one area of the painting to another and wiping the brush clean enough to load it with a new color.

I came away with the observation that concentrating on a painting and talking about painting are two very different modes of thinking. One really has to be shut down to do the other. Thus, the artist may re-do a painting he has done before to illustrate techniques, etc. and talk about it, but if he wants to create something new he will have to give it his full attention, which would rule out questions and discussion. As a result, we have demos where the artist brings nearly completed works and adds a few strokes, or perhaps brings several works in various stages of completion. Is one better than the other? That's up to you. What would you like to take with you from the demo? Personally, I like them all!

Myra's demonstration will be on how to paint in watercolor on the synthetic paper surface called "Tyvek." She will be using liquid Hydrus watercolors. Different techniques and materials will be shown because of the nature of the surface of the paper. The demonstration from drawing to finished painting will take between an hour and 90 minutes.
