Ferenc Besze, born and raised in Budapest, Hungary, has loved art since childhood. Today, Ferenc transfers his passion to his students by teaching watercolor, which is his primary medium.

This talented, award-winning watercolorist prefers to express himself in an impressionistic style, focusing on the essence of the subject, rather than dwelling on details. He likes all subject matter equally, such as a peaceful landscape or a busy city scene.

Ferenc accomplishes his unique wide range of color with a surprisingly limited palette, and maintains economy of design. His free-flowing spontaneous style brings out the beautiful characteristics of watercolor. His technique is influenced significantly by traditional as well as impressionist masters.

His paintings are in private collections in the United States and Europe. Ferenc's work was featured in the millennium issue of the International Artists Magazine, Master Painters of the World section. He is a signature member of SWA.
