

ALL STUDENT LEVELS: Here is a class that gets you out *IN IT*! Watercolor is a wonderful, simple, and portable medium. It is perfect for capturing quick, colorful sketches and small paintings on your hikes and travels. Painting "en plein aire" allows you to see true colors and light, and teaches you to paint what you see before you.

During this two day workshop, you will learn basic watercolor skills, proper use of the medium, and how to prepare for outdoor painting. Supplies and preparation for painting outside will be covered. One day will be spent on location at Foothills Park in Palo Alto with a concluding critique at the end of the day.

During both days, the instructor will work individually with students on composition, design, mixing color that you see, using flat and gradated washes, and how to paint outside in an efficient, effective and comfortable manner.

Steve will be giving an watercolor demonstration on **Saturday**, **March 20th**, from 1:00 - 3:00 PM at the Society of Western Artists Gallery in Redwood City.
